



James (Jim) Mallon BURSARY POLICY

Jim was one of the founders of the UFPC and the driving force behind it from 2001 to 2012, when he retired from being a Foster Parent. Jim's career in life was teaching and helping to guide all children towards adulthood.

In order to honour Jim's two major commitments in life, the Board of the UFPC has setup a bursary, for children and grandchildren of the United Foster Parents of Canada (UFPC) members that attend a full-time post-secondary institution. One bursary is to be awarded to a person studying in the educational field.

All funds donated to the UFPC in Jim's name (after his death) have been directed towards this bursary.

The amount of funds available for the James (Jim) Mallon BURSARY will be \$500 each year, for a maximum period of 10 years. (2016-2026)

Bursary Requirements:

- All Applications are due at the UFPC office by May 31, each year. Hard copy or email accepted.
- Applicant must be the biological or adopted child or grandchild of the UFPC Member or under legal guardianship and legal custody that were not previous crown wards **and not previously awarded a bursary from the UFPC.**
- Applications available online at www.ufpc.com
- Proof of registration to the post-secondary institution is due at the UFPC office by August 31, each year. Proof can take the form of a timetable, part or whole payment, or OSAP approval documentation. For the upcoming academic year.
- Selection of the successful applicant for the James (Jim) Mallon bursary will be done by random draw, (from *only* the applicants that applied for this bursary) and that will take place at UFPC September Board Meeting.
- Carol Mallon will be notified who is the successful applicant.
- Bursary will be distributed in the fall of each year
